













WE House Project Information Sheet

The Women Empowerment House (WE House) is a collaborative space for workers, shared and jointly run by the Women's Union Network, Solidarity Center with funding support from USAID and GIZ's regional "Promoting Sustainability in the Textile and Garment Industry in Asia" (FABRIC) programme.

The WE House provides a space where workers can access a supportive environment which provides for learning and recreation where they can discuss work-related and gender- specific issues and access relevant support services. Situated in close proximity to Veng Sreng Boulevard where many garment factories are located and an estimated 40,000 - 50,000 workers reside, the WE House has a specific focus on reaching young women workers from the garment industry.

The objectives of the WE House project are to:

- Increase the knowledge of workers about their labour rights and responsibilities and life skills with a particular focus on women garment workers.
- Provide a space where workers can access relevant support services such as legal advice, counselling and health education.
- Provide capacity building opportunities to the WUN members and their respective unions to increase their knowledge and organizational capacities to promote labour rights and address gender-based issues such as discrimination and violence and harassment.

Proposed Activities, Services and Facilities

- Sunday Trainings and other educational workshops including topics prioritized by workers and unions such as:
 - Labour Law; gender and society; understanding contracts and entitlements; social protection; workplace and community safety and security; financial management and budgeting; and other educational and life-skills topics.
- Counselling services accessible to workers: legal, psychosocial, financial
- Exchange Café a free space to exchange and find support among peers
- Workspace with computers, internet access, library and WIFI access
- Event space available for the Women's Union Network and other unions to reserve for use
- Mapping and linking with social services in the locality
